### Registration

All participants will be required to sign in before the event starts. All parents need to provide a mobile number they can be contacted at when registering to enable contact to be made if required.

All participants must bring their own materials on the day. Maximum paper size is A3.

**Participant name, date of birth and area must be written on the back of paper prior to attending the event to ensure it can be identified.**

The use of aerosols (spray paint etc.) in Art competitions is not allowed Maximum time 3 hours allowed

Community Games Art Rules – Clare Area finals, 16th, 17th & 18th May 2023

1. An exhibit must be based on a Community Games Activity.
2. At the County competition, Under the supervision of the adjudicators competitors will be required to paint, draw, sketch or collage: o Under 8s & Under 10s Under 12, Under 14 & Under 16 his/her own choice of any Community Games activity.
3. A competitor will enter only one exhibit at each level of competition.
4. An exhibit may be a painting / drawing / collage or a cartoon
5. Competitors must bring all their own materials on the day including paper.
6. A supervised competition must be held at both area and county level.
7. Adjudication will be based on: -
  - Observation of Events: 20 Marks
  - Creativity and Originality: 30 Marks
  - Natural Ability: 50 Marks
8. The winning Exhibits (medal winners will be on display for 10 minutes after completion of the judging process. Exhibits remaining after the display time will be available at the next County meeting after which any remaining exhibits will be disposed of.7. Maximum size of an exhibit in the Art competition will be A3 size. No surround allowed

9. Competitors will use their own choice of paper in accordance with Rule 9

10. All materials must be scrutinized prior to the commencement of competition and if any material is deemed to be prepared, the competitor will be automatically disqualified.

11. Visual aids i.e. photographs, newspaper cuttings, transfers, etc., will not be permitted and adjudicators will request the removal of any item they consider as helping the competitor.
